

### Our Mission


Transition Club focuses on providing a platform for students to acquire photography skills and showcase them with their peers.



- Photos that show the view from a window will not be considered
- The photo that has the best quality/composition/message conveyed will win
- Max 2 photographs allowed per entry. If it exceeds 2 photographs, the entry as a whole will not be considered.
- Photographs must be free of any borders, watermarks or signatures. Basic light and colour corrections permitted.
- Heavy digital manipulation (Photoshop) not allowed.
- The photo must not be a screenshot and should not be compressed. The photo must be a minimum of 1.5 MB.

- The images are to be color corrected and external elements can be added while maintaining a level of realism.
- Software to be used is upto the participant and some recommendations will be provided along with the link to the pictures.

#### Rules

- This competition is valid for Students from Grade 9 to Grade 12 (Boys).
- The last day to mail in your entries: 02-01-2021
- Participants are categorised based on their grade and one winner will be announced per
  grade. All entries are to be sent to <u>president.transition@gmail.com</u> with your name as the
  subject and your grade and section in the subject along with the picture. Also, please attach
  the original picture and the newly edited picture in the form of a compressed ZIP folder.
- Photographs must be free of any borders, watermarks or signatures.
- Landscape Shots, Animal Portraits, Macro Shots are permitted.
- The use of filters and presets are prohibited.
- Human Portrait edits are strictly prohibited. Pictures of religious places and government buildings as entries will not be accepted.
- Any inappropriate submission may lead to disciplinary action against the participant.
- Your final image can be attached as a .jpeg, .jpg or .png format in the aforementioned way.
   Only <u>ONE</u> finished image is accepted. Resending entries may lead to disqualification.
